



**STATEMENT OF WITNESS**

Continuation of Statement of: **Albert John FRENCH**

The Police re-visited me in Duxford on 8<sup>th</sup> March 1990. On this occasion they brought with them 23 different samples of laminates, produced by various manufacturers. I was asked to analyse each laminate sample in turn, and see if they matched the original sample I had previously examined.

I conducted a series of tests on each sample, building up a library of 23 individual spectra. The original spectrum was searched against these using the built in algorithm on the computer.

I can say that no exact match was found against the original fragment. The most similar make up were from samples produced by SEFOLAM of Israel, and DITRON of Italy.

I informed the police of my findings by letter, on 9<sup>th</sup> March 1990, and they were subsequently incorporated in a witness statement.
